Functional Anatomy of the Respiratory System. The nasal cavity, the chamber within the nose, is divided medially by a nasal septum and separated from the oral cavity by the palate ( Figure 13.1 ). The nasal cavity is lined with a mucosa, which warms, filters, and moistens incoming air. The mucosa also contains receptors for sense of smell.
